

Geology BA: Four-year plan

The following is an idealized plan for completing the BA in Geology and the General Education program in four years. There is a considerable amount of flexibility. However, we strongly encourage students to fulfill the math and allied science requirements as early as possible. Note that these two program together fulfill only 128 of the 180 total credits and 44-48 of the 60 credits at the 300- and 400-levels needed to graduate from CWU.

The BA in Geology partially satisfies the criteria for a teaching endorsement in Earth Science (5-12), and can be paired with the STEM Teaching Program—the plan below allows for student teaching in the final quarter.
