

## Geology BS: Four-year plan

The following schedule is an idealized plan for completing the BS in Geology and the General Education program in four years. There is a considerable amount of flexibility. However, we strongly encourage students to fulfill the chemistry and math requirements as early as possible. Note that this plan fulfills 157 of the 180 total credits and 54 of the 60 credits at the 300- and 400-levels needed to graduate from CWU.
